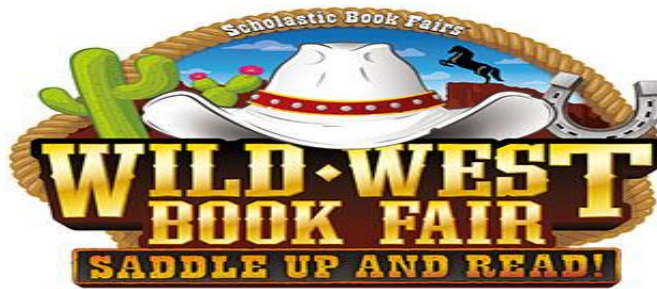

### ❖ TWO TIMES TO SHOP

Your child will have the opportunity to shop the book fair during his/her library class time during the week of Monday, October 9 through Friday, October 13. Please refer to the schedule attached to this flyer for your child's specific class time. If you would like your child to shop during library class, please place his/her money in a Ziploc bag or envelope with your child's name and section on it. You may also make a check out to the HPTO and let us know how much your child may spend at the fair. Please note that we must collect sales tax on book fair sales.

You also have the opportunity to shop with your child during our family event on Thursday, October 12, 2017 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Our family event is held in conjunction with the Hartwood Elementary Open House Night!!

Shopping the book fair is a great way to support your child's reading while benefiting the PTO, as 50% of the proceeds from the book fair are given back to the PTO. We can use that money to buy books for the classrooms, the library, and for children in Hartwood that cannot afford to buy new books.

### ❖ TEACHER WISH BASKETS

Teachers at Hartwood have the opportunity to preview the fair and assemble a wish basket for their classroom. Please take a moment and visit your classroom wish baskets that will be displayed in the library during the fair. Parents and students can purchase a book directly from the basket to give to their teacher. Please make sure to grab a sticker when you check out so that your teacher knows who donated the book.
