- Lived from October 31, 1760
 May 10, 1849
- WAS A JAPANESE ARTIST
- SELF-PORTRAIT TO THE RIGHT.....





+ HOKUSAI BEGAN PAINTING AROUND THE AGE OF SIX

*POSSIBLY LEARNING THE ART FROM HIS FATHER, WHO WAS A MIRRORS MAKER AND ALSO INCLUDED THE PAINTING OF DESIGNS AROUND THE MIRRORS

+AT THE AGE OF 12, HE WAS SENT BY HIS FATHER TO WORK IN A BOOKSHOP -WHERE READING BOOKS MADE FROM WOOD-CUT BLOCKS WAS A POPULAR ENTERTAINMENT FOR THE MIDDLE AND UPPER CLASSES

+AT 14, HE BECAME AN APPRENTICE TO A WOOD-CARVER



+HOKUSAI WAS A PAINTER AND PRINTER. HE USUALLY MADE HIS ARTWORK ON SILK PAPER.
