2. Financial Report- Mandy

- Our updated financial report.
- Book fair raised over \$2,000.
- Apparel sale raised around \$600.

- Fall Festival came in under budget.
- PTO provided funding to support participation in the spelling bee.
- 2022-2023 Audit is due by the end of December.
- We need to put together an audit committee and choose a date to meet.
- We need 1 volunteer from the general membership and 1 non-member volunteer. The audit entails reviewing financial records from the 22-23 school year. Each audit member reviews documentation to confirm that the receipts and the checks etc. match. Katie Parker volunteered her husband so we still need a non-member to volunteer.

3. Voting Matters- Heather

A. Grocery Gift Cards for Guidance

- The Guidance Dept. has identified 32 families that need assistance.
- We would like to donate grocery gift cards to help these families.
- We need 11 people to vote if we are spending more than \$1,000.
- Vote is for \$25 gift cards for both Thanksgiving and again in December. This will use the \$1,650 donation we received from a local church.

B. Field Trip T-Shirts

- We are pursuing a collaboration with Antler Grafix for our t-shirts.
- Shirts will cost approx. \$5.60 each and be 50/50 cotton blend.
- Our shirt count as given by teachers is: 393 students + 5 teachers.
- After the board gets a formal quote and votes on it, the vote must go out to the general PTO membership to be approved.

C. Winter Holiday Parties

- Parties have changed based on teacher input.
- As such, we are potentially going to go over budget to become more in line with the changes.
- The Winter Party Committee is working very hard to reuse/repurpose what we have as well as finding inexpensive materials.
- The board can authorize up to \$199 over budget; \$200+ must be voted on by general membership.
